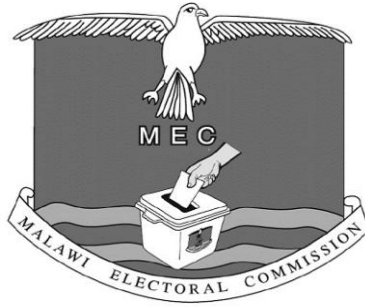




ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE DETERMINATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS 2025

29th September 2025

SALUTATIONS

My fellow Malawians

It is with a deep sense of humility and satisfaction that we, the Malawi Electoral Commission, come here today to perform this noble task of announcing the results for the Parliamentary Elections held on 16 September 2025.

Let me, begin by thanking the Lord God Almighty for sustaining us this far from the time we went to the polls and started determination of the results thereafter. We commend Malawians for maintaining peace and calm throughout the process, and believe will continue to do so.

My fellow Malawians, following the release of the presidential election results on 24th September 2025, the Commission immediately focused on the parliamentary elections records. According to law the Commission has up to 14 days from the day of polling to declare the parliamentary election results. So today, on 13th day, we are here with the partial results. But before I declare the results, let me address a few issues.

Uncontested parliamentary seat

My fellow Malawians, in Lilongwe Chilobwe Constituency, Parliamentary elections did not take place because there was only one candidate who was duly nominated - Mr Lawrence Chaziya of the Malawi Congress Party and he got the seat uncontested.

Constituencies where elections were postponed or nullified

My fellow Malawians, there are some constituencies where elections did not take place or have been nullified for various reasons as follows:

1. Blantyre West Constituency: Elections were postponed because of death of Mr Michael Izeck Chisala who was candidate for the Malawi Congress Party. The Commission will announce in due course when the by-elections will be held in this area.
2. Nkhotalakota Liwaladzi Constituency: the Commission announced a suspension in this constituency following a court order after one of the aspiring candidates, Mr Daniel Binda, applied to the court for a review of the Commission's decision rejecting his nomination for paying less than the prescribed nomination fee for Parliamentary Election.
3. Dedza Mtakakata Constituency: elections were suspended following a court ruling in a case whereby one of the candidates, Mr Charles J. Sandram applied for a review of the Commission's decision rejecting his nomination for paying less than the prescribed nomination fee for Parliamentary Election.
4. Lilongwe City Mtandire-Mtsiriza Constituency: The electoral process in the constituency have been nullified because the Commission was rendered unable to determine the results with certainty because the tamper evident envelopes containing the void votes were opened irregularly at the Council.

The Commission had received complaints related to examination of void votes for the election in the constituency. The Commission has had the occasion to consider the complaints and has formed the view that the handling of the polling materials, at the Council, especially the void votes, departed from the legally set procedure. The staff at the council did not have the authority to open the tamper-evident envelopes and examine the void votes. This was a serious misconduct and has caused a serious irregularity which has rendered the Commission unable to determine the results with certainty and has, therefore, resolved that the parliamentary election in the constituency be nullified or cancelled. The Commission will hold a by-election in the same manner as if there was a vacancy, on a date to be set and announced.

Examination of void results

Ladies and gentlemen, in accordance with Section 96(1) and (2) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, the Commission is supposed to examine votes classified as void at the polling stations and to affirm or correct the decisions of the Presiding Officers. The Commission will not release results for constituencies where the total number of void votes is greater than the difference between the first and second placed candidates until the void votes have been examined.

The results of the following constituencies are pending examination of the void votes:

1. Mzimba South East
2. Nkhata Bay Central

Receipt of complaints

My fellow Malawians, during polling and results management, the Commission received a number of complaints. As required under section 96 (1) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, 2023, all complaints have been considered and determined and the complainants have been issued with comprehensive responses in writing. The decisions taken on the complaints have been recorded in the Record of Determination of Results which will be published in the Gazette as required by law.

Regarding any concerns among political parties and candidates about the results, they are entitled to file petitions in the High Court within seven days.

Declaration of Parliamentary Election Results

The Commission has thoroughly reviewed and determined all the complaints that were lodged for the Parliamentary Election in relation to the results that we are releasing today and we declare the Parliamentary Elections to be free and fair and that the results are a true reflection of the will of the people of the respective constituencies.

Let me emphasize here that the candidates being announced have been voted for by the voters. The Commission only facilitates the process to enable voters to choose leaders of their choice. There will always be one winner. I repeat ONE WINNER.

Therefore, in accordance with Sections 96 (1) and (2), 97 and 98(1) (b) and 98(2) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections Act, 2023, I, Justice Annabel Mtalimanja hereby declare the following candidates as having been elected as Members of Parliament in the respective Constituencies: -
